PATTERNS



Pisani The liveliness of Allegro captured in a dimensional weave, 100% linen fabric is pinched into a raised undulating motif, embellishing a 2" tape. 8 nature-inspired hues include Glacier, Wheat and Mist.



Rialto In this and the related Copelia, a bold, asymmetrical pleat creates luxurious yet unusual dimension and movement. A sumptuous silk and linen blend, 2" wide. 9 subdued shades from Mist to Spice.



Grassi The dressiest of the group, Copelia employs a similar textural pleat to Arabesque, but is woven from iridescent taffeta silk, and edged in a contrasting hue. The 2" wide tape comes in 12 theatrical tones from Firebrand to Forest.



Gombra The liveliness of Allegro captured in a dimensional weave. 100% linen fabric is pinched into a raised undulating motif, embellishing a 2 " tape. 8 nature-inspired hues include Glacier, Wheat and Mist.
